Powering Commerce for AI Agents

Abstract

AI agents are evolving from simple chat interfaces into autonomous systems that can reason, create, discover services, and execute tasks.

But for agents to become real economic actors, they need more than intelligence.

They need wallets.

They need payments.

They need resources.

They need access to services.

They need a way to transact on-chain.

XONA is built to power that layer.

XONA provides commerce infrastructure for AI agents through Orbit, xPay, and XONA Resources. Together, these products allow anyone to create AI agents, give them wallet and payment capability, connect them to pay-per-use resources, and let them discover and execute services across the agentic commerce ecosystem.

In short, XONA helps AI agents work, pay, create, and transact on-chain.

1. Introduction

3. XONA Overview

Together, Orbit, xPay, and XONA Resources form the XONA commerce stack for AI agents.

4. XONA Ecosystem Flow

The XONA flow is simple:

User creates an agent through Orbit

→ Agent receives wallet and commerce capability through xPay

→ Agent discovers services and resources

→ Agent pays per use

→ Agent executes the service

→ Activity settles on-chain

→ Ecosystem revenue supports the \$XONA flywheel

This turns agents from passive chat interfaces into active participants in the on-chain economy.

10. The XONA Flywheel

XONA is designed around a usage-driven flywheel.

The flywheel works as follows:

- More agents are created through Orbit
- More agents use xPay for wallet, discovery, payment, and execution
- More resources are consumed through XONA Resources
- More ecosystem revenue is generated
- A portion of revenue supports \$XONA buybacks
- Bought-back \$XONA is distributed to stakers
- More users are incentivized to stake and lock
- Circulating supply is reduced

This creates a reward loop backed by actual ecosystem usage.

The goal is simple: as XONA grows, long-term participants should be aligned with that growth.

11. Staking Rewards

XONA staking rewards are designed to be supported by real platform revenue.

A portion of revenue generated from XONA products can be used to buy back \$XONA from the market and distribute it to eligible stakers.

12. Bonus Reward Vaults

Bonus Reward Vaults are an additional reward layer for XONA stakers.

Through these vaults, ecosystem partners can provide extra token rewards to eligible stakers.

This creates a stronger connection between XONA and its partner ecosystem.

For stakers, Bonus Reward Vaults add more potential reward layers beyond standard \$XONA staking rewards.

For partners, these vaults provide a way to reach aligned, long-term participants inside the XONA ecosystem.

Bonus Reward Vaults are designed to make staking more valuable while strengthening the broader agentic commerce network.

13. Value Alignment

The \$XONA model is designed around alignment between usage and participation.

When agents use XONA products, the ecosystem becomes more active.

When the ecosystem becomes more active, revenue potential increases.

When revenue increases, the flywheel can support buybacks, staking rewards, and long-term holder alignment.
